



# HAZ-MAT COLLECTION DAY

The Walton Board of County Commissioners is sponsoring a project to collect, recycle, treat, and properly dispose of these and other household hazardous wastes:

- PESTICIDES • USED OIL • STALE GASOLINE • SOLVENTS • FERTILIZERS • PAINT •
- PAINT THINNERS • PAINT STRIPPERS • BATTERIES • BATTERIES • FURNITURE POLISH •
- BRAKE FLUID • ENGINE DEGREASERS • ANTI-FREEZE •
- POOL CHEMICALS • INSECTICIDES • SPOT REMOVERS

Waste tire amnesty will also be held on the same date, during the same hours and locations. Walton County residents may bring up to 12 tires per residence.

**South Walton Mosquito Control Office, County Road 393, Santa Rosa Beach**

- Due to hazardous nature of certain components in home computers, we will be accepting old computer hardware including processors, monitors, keyboards, printers, scanners, etc.
