

## EMERGENCY BOARD MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of the South Walton County Mosquito Control District held an Emergency Board Meeting at the headquarters office in Santa Rosa Beach, Florida at 1:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was for the Vacant Director Position.

The Commissioners attending the meeting were Robert Hudson, John Magee and James Crawford. Also attending the meeting were Office Manager Geraldine Via, and Secretary Cynthia Dillingham.

Commissioner Magee submitted resumes that he had received from John Smith and Edward Horvath regarding the Vacant Director Position.

The Board discussed the minimum requirements for the Director III position. The applicant must have four year degree in basic science or engineering and two years work experience in mosquito control. The applicant must also have a Public Health Pest Control license in order to take the Director's Certification Exam. The Board decided to place advertisements in The Pensacola News Journal, The Northwest Florida Daily News, The Panama City News Herald, and Monster.com. The applications will be accepted until Monday, July 11, 2011.

The Board asked Mrs. Via to send letter to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services informing them of the termination of the Director and that the District is actively seeking a replacement. She was also asked to contact the bank to update signature cards removing Stephen Sickerman from all accounts.
